- 6) Scanned copy of a valid residence permit, in case the candidate holds one already (for NON-EU citizens);
- 7) (not compulsory) Up to two reference letters (in English) Academic and industrial mentors may act as referees.

If the required documents are not written in English or Italian, they should be accompanied by a translation in English.

Applications that are not accompanied by all the requested documents or received after the closing date (May 5<sup>th</sup> 2025) will not be considered under any circumstances.
